

## **Installation Warnings when installing applications like Polls by Pollimath on the T-Mobile G1.**

When installing Polls on the T-Mobile G1 (or other Android phones if any), there is likely to be some warnings thrown as a precaution by the hardware vendor. We want you to stop worrying and understand each of these warnings, so you won't be scared off from installing and using Polls by Pollimath freely.

### **Network Communications; Full Internet Access**

This means that Polls will use your mobile Internet bandwidth to connect to our secure web service and store your poll data and display the Poll Results. The Internet bandwidth consumption for this activity is minimal and contained; no continuous usage of Internet occurs simply because you install Polls.

### **Services That Cost You Money; Send SMS Messages**

This means if you choose to Open a poll with a selected list of voters, the voters will be notified by SMS, if you have chosen SMS as the poll delivery method. For Polls V1.0.1 SMS is the only delivery method, but for Polls Premium 1.0.0 E-Mail is also a delivery method. In any case, the exact number of SMS is flashed as a double check before a poll is Opened. This is entirely in your control.

### **Your Personal Information; Read Contacts**

Polls allows you to select voters from your list of Google contacts via your Contacts application. Nothing more here.

### **Phone Calls; Read Phone State**

Polls reads your phone identifier to ensure uniqueness of your Polls. Nothing more here.
